Who shares the space?


What will you need in your shared space? Why?

Writing

*Create 4 characters you'd like to have in your story. Draw them and use your imagination by telling me some interesting things about them.

*Write a story on a topic of your choice. Try to include describing words, interesting verbs and different kinds of punctuation.

*If you have written a story on Tuesday or Wednesday, make it into a book. Remember to include a front cover and illustrations.

*Bring your writing to school share with your teacher and classmates.

Maths

Solve one of the place value challenges below. Record your thinking and show your teacher.

What do you know and what can you find out about the number

Think about what we have been learning about how our number system works.

Make as many numbers as you can using the digits

6 5 8

What is the smallest number you can make?

What is the greatest 3-digit number you can make?

What is the greatest number you can make that you understand?

Draw a picture to show one of the numbers you made.
