Help farmer Joe preserve his orange crop


4. **Bonus Activities:**





Can you write a place value riddle?

Try “Reading as a Writer” today!

Write a “Quick Write” today

Just 10 minutes continuous writing, (but more if you like) try not to stop, write for the whole 10 minutes.

You can write about anything you want but if you are stuck for an idea how about:

“A moment you’ll never forget..”

or “The best thing that has ever happened to me”

or “The worst thing that has ever happened to me”

Your challenge as you write is to start one of your sentences with where e.g.

In the garden I dug a hole.

Under the mat, I hid from my friend.

Behind the tree, I hid from my friend.

Through the grass, I crept.

Down the hill, I pedalled fast.

Across the lake, the wind blew.

Don't forget when you have finished your writing check for correct use of capital letters and did you manage to start a sentence with where? If not, could you go back and change a sentence to start with where?

Write a list of all the things he could do.


