1-Draw out how you would share 6 pizzas among 9 children


2-Draw out sharing 9 between 6.

- How a place/building came to be in Hong Kong e.g. The story of how Lion Rock appeared in Hong Kong.


Or it may be about something else that you consider to link to our unit about heritage.
