Dear Year Three Families,

I regret to inform you that we crossed The Centre for Health Protection (CHP) reporting threshold for upper respiratory tract infections (URTI) today in Year Three. The CHP has responded to our report by ordering a five-day (including Saturday and Sunday) closure (transmission circuit-breaker) of Year Three at KJS. The details of the closure are as follows:

1. Year Three will move to online learning from Wednesday 8/12 until Friday 10/12 inclusive.
2. Year Three students may not enter the KJS campus during this period.
3. As per previous CHP correspondence, all Year Three students will be expected to attend a community Covid-19 testing centre. They will need to provide proof that they are KJS students in order to have a free test. Please note that the compulsory testing order will only be released tomorrow night so students will be unable to receive a test until Thursday.
4. Wednesday will be asynchronous learning (offline tasks) shared with you at 10:30 a.m.
5. Thursday and Friday will be synchronous (live) online learning.
6. School Chromebooks and chargers will be available for collection tomorrow if required. This can be arranged by contacting: [ictsupport@kjs.edu.hk](mailto:ictsupport@kjs.edu.hk)
7. Your child's teacher will be in touch to provide further details including Zoom links.
8. The Year Three classrooms and shared areas will undergo a deep cleaning process during the closure.
