KJS BUS CHARTER

At KJS our School Bus Providers promise that...

- Drivers and Chaperones (Bus Mums) will:
- Ensure all children are accounted for; checking with the School Office regarding any missing children before the bus departs from school
- Ensure all children are sitting down with seatbelts on before the bus starts moving; and that they remain in their seats with seatbelts attached throughout the journey, between home and school
- Ensure all children are only handed over to a recognised family member or other authorised adult, when being dropped off after school
 - Ensure children do not eat or are offered food on the bus
- Inform the school immediately by phone if the bus has been delayed by more than 10 minutes for any reason
 - Inform the school as soon as possible should the bus be involved in any sort of accident (however minor) during the journey between home and school
 - Inform the school as soon as possible regarding any injury (including minor bumps etc.) to students during the journey between home and school
 - Inform the school regarding any child who fails to comply with the basic bus behavior rules
 - Present the <u>Bus Behaviour Log Book</u> to the School Office every Friday for examination
 - Drivers are fully trained and qualified to transport children
 - Drivers will adhere strictly to the speed limit
 - Drivers will not use inappropriate language in front of students
- Buses are fitted with properly installed permanent seatbelts; and no child will be allocated a seat without a seatbelt
- They will provide the school with a full list of student names and classes travelling by bus at the start of the academic year; and update the school on a regular basis regarding any changes to that list
- Parents will be provided with contact (mobile) numbers of Bus Driver and Chaperones
 (Bus Mums)
- A KJS "Safe Driver" notice with school telephone number will be displayed on all buses
- Immediate disciplinary action will be taken against any Driver/ Chaperone (Bus Mum)
 who puts children at risk by failing to comply with the KJS Bus Charter
