- 3. Don't name or tag children in photos even though this is not a public group, we are still following the best practice guidelines when it comes to the use of photos of children. You can post pictures of groups of students, but don't name them individually just refer to their class or year group.
- 4. Ask your child if you are posting about them in line with our approach to digital citizenship, it is good social media etiquette to ask your child if they are ok with you making a post about them. If they are ok with it, then you are good to go.
- 5. If in doubt then don't post if you are unsure about whether or not it is appropriate to post something in the group, then you probably already have your answer







We have never done this before, so we are going to try it out between now and the end of the term. It is not compulsory, nor is it replacing any of the traditional means of contacting the school with questions or concerns. We will review it at the end of the term and see if it is something that the community supports – or if we need to make some adjustments. There will be a short joining and approval process for families, but we aim to make this as easy as possible.
