We have been using our understanding in fractions to solve problems and investigate different ways to divide shapes. Being able to talk about different 'models' of fractions has helped to develop a better conceptual understanding. A very common misconception when transferring meaning to a numerical form is to talk about 'the number on the top and the number on the bottom'. This confuses children because **the whole fraction is the number**. A simple change in the language that we use to explain how it is notated can avoid years of 'fear' of fractions. Instead,
